Meetings 1<sup>st</sup> Wed of every Month Minutes from **03 Oct 2012** meeting

1900 hours: meeting called to order by Cmdr. Jim Irwin.

Chief of the Boat led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

Base Chaplain Janet Irwin offered an opening prayer and gave the invocation.

- Base muster: 25 members present.
- The bell was tolled for Boats lost during the month of October:
- **S 37** (SS-142) 10 Oct 1923 3 died. Battery explosion in after battery compartment while battery charging in harbor at San Pedro, California.
- **O-5** (SS-66) 20 Oct 1923 3 died. Rammed and sunk by United Fruit steamer Abangarez in Limon Bay, Canal Zone.
- **S 44** (SS-155) 07 Oct 1943 56 killed. Sunk by Japanese Shumushu class escort Ishigaki, northeast Ariaito Island off Kamchatka. Two survivors, both repatriated at end of war.
- USS Wahoo (SS-238) 11 Oct 1943 80 killed. Sunk by Japanese naval aircraft, submarine chasers Ch 15 and Ch 43, and minesweeper W.18 in La Perouse Strait off Japan.
- USS Dorado (SS-248) 12 Oct 1943 77 killed mistakenly attacked with depth charges by a U.S. Navy flying boat on the night of October 12, 1943. Hull has never been found.
- USS Seawolf (SS-197) 03 Oct 1944 100 died. Mistakenly sunk by naval aircraft from escort carrier USS Midway (CVE-63) and USS Richard M. Rowell (DE-403) off Morotai Island.
- USS Escolar (SS-294) 17 Oct 1944 82 killed –most likely lost due to mine detonation in the Yellow Sea.

- **USS Darter** (SS-227) 24 Oct 1944 0 died. Ran aground on Bombay Shoal, Palawan Passage; later scuttled by USS Nautilus (SS-168) and USS Dace (SS-247).
- USS Tang (SS-306) 24 Oct 1944 78 died, 9 POWs survived. Accidentally sunk by circular run of own torpedo in Formosa Strait.

Reading of the minutes for the previous meeting was waived.

Base Treasurer Randy Stein had previously posted the base financial report for the month of October via email and on line.

• Albany Law Veterans Rights Pro Bono Project –facilitates free legal advice to veterans and their families.
