MINUTES OF MEETING ALBANY-SARATOGA BASE, USSVI

Base Commander's Report

Base Commander Jim Irwin and Base Chaplain Janet Irwin recently visited the widow of the executive officer of USS Tang. He was lost when the boat went down. They have become close friends and the widow has informed them she is going to bequeath USS Tang memorabilia upon her passing to the USSVI Albany-Saratoga Base. This includes his original Navy Cross Medal with the Presidential Letter of Commendation, (2) Presidential Unit Citations, a Purple Heart, and Meritorious Service Awards. Also, there are original letters from Admiral Nimitz and Admiral Lockwood informing her of the loss of USS Tang.

Member Ron Barrett was inducted into the Holland Club with a ceremony conducted by Base Commander Jim Irwin and USSVI National Commander Al Singleman. A standing ovation was given to him as he was welcomed into this prestigious club.

Float: Bill Preece informed Base Members that repairs needed on the float will be can be done with the help of BOCES. Requests will be made in the near future to see if they would be willing to take this on as a project. Materials may need to be provided by the base, but details will be

worked out and presented to the membership. Al Singleman will make copies of the Conning Tower plans for the committee working on the float.

Base Commander, Jim Irwin thanked everyone who voted in the USSVI National Elections. National average for voting was 14% with Albany-Saratoga's online voting was at 20% (not counting the mail in ballots).

Base Picnic: The Picnic was a huge success, with a great turnout of Base Members. Fred Miller received the second highest USSVI Award – the Robert Link Award for his outstanding work on the Highway Project. Press Conference on Highway Project: Thursday, October 6 at 1030 is the press conference for renaming Route 9. Meeting place is BJ's B-B-QSA on Route 9 in Saratoga Springs. Politicians and News Media will be present for this event. DOT will provide at least two signs, one Northbound and Southbound. The official name will be "The United States Submarine Veterans Memorial Highway – Saratoga" and it will run the length of Route 9 in Saratoga County from the Crescent Bridge to South Glens Falls for a total of 40 miles. This is a National initiative with a goal to have roads named in every state.

Sub Vet License Plate Project: In New York the license will have a minor change with coloring in the background to the USSVI National insignia.
