Jim then advised everyone that on September 25<sup>th</sup> the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors is sponsoring their annual Concert at SPAC. The US Army Field Band will play. Gates open at 5:00pm and the concert begins at 7:00pm. The concert is open to the public and is free of charge. Saratoga County veterans receive their tickets in the mail, others can get their tickets at any Saratoga County Stewarts store or ask Jim and he will send them to you.

Jim then handed out copies of the written history forms and asked all veterans (Sub Vets and non Sub Vets included) to complete the form as completely as possible and return it to either him or Janet. (Not all the questions will apply to everyone who completes the form) You can return it at a meeting, mail it to Jim at the address shown at the end of the minutes, or you can enclose it when you send your dues in to the Base Treasurer (presently Fred Carlson) when you pay for 2010. (You can send them in any time beginning the second week in September- after the convention)

This form was emailed to the membership and will be included with the August minutes for those who do not have email. Also, if you were not able to print out a copy of the form let me know and I will mail you a copy.
