Location: American Legion Henry Cornell Post 234 23 Pleasant Street, Ballston Spa, NY

Minutes from 03 Apr 2013 meeting

1900 hours: regular meeting called to order by CDR Irwin with 21 members present.

• Chief of the Boat led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.

Ten-Hut! As of 11 Mar 2013, Albany-Saratoga Base now has 117 members!

- We have 1 new Associate Member! Welcome Aboard mate!
- Dawn M. Saville Sponsor: base member Gus Negus
- Base Chaplain Janet Irwin offered an opening prayer, gave the invocation and tolled the bell for boats lost during the month of April:

USS Pickerel (SS-177) 03 Apr 1943 - 59 killed. Sunk by Japanese destroyer Yamakaze; Makassar Strait, 120 miles east of Menado, Celebes.

- **USS Grenadier (SS-210)** 22 Apr 1943 76 POWs, 4 later died. Scuttled after Japanese seaplane attacks (936 Kokutai) the previous day, off Penang, Malaysia.
- **USS Gudgeon (SS-211)** 18 Apr 1944 79 killed sunk by Japanese naval aircraft (901st Kokutai) 166 nautical miles southeast of Iwo Jima.
- USS Snook (SS-279) 09 Apr 1945 84 killed. Probably sunk by kaibokans <u>Okinawa</u>, CD-8, CD-32 and CD-52; and/or Japanese submarine I-56 in the Nansei Soto.
- USS Thresher (SSN-593) 10 Apr 1963 129 died. Sank after a possible piping failure during deep dive trials southeast of Cape Cod Massachusetts. April 10 marks the 50th anniversary of this historic tragedy. A 129-foot flagpole was dedicated the morning of April 7 at Memorial Circle in Kittery, Maine, to honor the 129 Navy sailors and civilian workers who died that day.

Base and associate members each stood, introduced themselves and stated the name of his qual boat and any other boats served on. Base Secretary Fritz Feldhaus verified a quorum was present.

Minutes from the March meeting have been previously distributed to members. Base member John Mishoe motioned to accept the minutes; base member Tom Glenn seconded; motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - Base Treasurer Randy Stein presented his report. Motion to accept: base member Bill Preece; second: base member Dean Bennett; Motion carried.

Base information notes

- Trip to Sub Base –Tour limited to 28 (set by Base Security). Date: 16 June 2013 (Father's Day). Departs Northway Exit 8 Park & Ride at 0630. Cost: \$65.00 per. (28 passenger bus = increased cost). 7-8 seats still available.
- **Memorial update**: informational plates are to be mounted on pedestals flanking the USS Albany submarine model; details to follow. Charlie McCormick will be doing the pedestals. Our memorial stone currently lists 476 names – 25 more are to be etched come this spring. Note that New York is the only state to memorialize all its sailors who were lost in submarines.
- New York State Auto License plate coordinator informs us that if you have a SUBVET plate, you MUST maintain your USSVI membership to keep your plate. The fee to apply for and obtain such a plate (if you don't already have one) is \$38.75. A custom plate (e.g., your boat's hull number) will cost you a one-time fee of \$70.00, plus an annual fee of \$31.25. There is a new form to use; copies are available on NYS DMV site.
- **Ship's Bell** from radar picket submarine USS Ray (SSR-271), on indefinite loan from the Naval Historical Foundation. Base Sr. Vice CDR John Christopher continues to work with CBM to have the bell properly mounted.
- USS Scorpion SSN 589 Memorial update: present at our base meeting today was Art Nolan and his wife, associate member Maryetta Nolan. As Chair of the USS Scorpion SSN 589 Memorial Committee, in appreciation for the kick-start we delivered to their "99 for 99" fund raising campaign for the 45th Anniversary Memorial Service, Art Nolan presented to our base a special edition SSN 589 Challenge Coin. Our base gift has been designated to sponsor Chief Hospital Corpsman LYNN THOMPSON SAVILLE from Fort Edward, New York. In accepting the coin for the base, CDR Jim Irwin pointed out the key efforts by National USSV in furthering the success of this fund raising campaign.
