MINUTES OF MEETING ALBANY-SARATOGA BASE, USSVI

The April meeting of the Albany-Saratoga Base was called to order by Base Commander Al Singleman at 1900 with 16 Base Members present.

- There were 10 people who responded they would attend a luncheon on April 11th if held. The decision was made to not hold the luncheon this year.

- The District Commander is having a Base Officer Zoom call on 4/9/24 to discuss District-wide issues. They desire to know what our base does that every base should do and what National can do to better the organization for the members.
- The NY Southern Tier base has been having trouble getting personnel to take positions on the board. They are considering being absorbed by another base and becoming a satellite group. This was done at the Groton base with success. We could use Groton's by-laws as a guide to help set up the relationship, if needed. A motion was made by Jim Stevens to offer to become the parent base for Southern Tier if they desire. The motion was seconded by Butch McCabe. The motion passed with no objections.
- Janet Irwin discussed that the Honor Flight organization is looking for people to
 write thank you cards for the mail call portion of the Honor Flight. Janet will start
 bringing cards to the next and subsequent meetings. You can pick up cards to fill out
 and bring them back and Janet will take them to the Honor Flight people. Jim Irwin
 spoke about the Honor Flight process and that they are taking veterans from the
 Cold War Era and what a positive experience it was.

- Jim Irwin discussed an upcoming ceremony being held by the USS ALBANY
 Association. The association will be dedicating restored sections of the USS ALBANY
 (CA-123/CG-10) bow section in the new Memorial Park. The event will be held on 11
 May, 2024 at 1100 at Rensselaer Riverfront Part at Broadway and 5th Ave in

- Base Member Kurt Semon is on the Board of Directors for the Capital Region Veterans Memorial, and they have been working on the Legacy Project. Kurt has talked with members of Subvets about this project in the past and noted part of past concern was how Cold War Submarine Veterans would be represented. On the website there is a map rendering of the final project. The map shows 8 conflict memorial areas, a reflection area, and a POW/MIA memorial area. A ninth conflict memorial area is not shown on the map but has been created on the site. It was an educational moment for the Team. This conflict is identified as "Expeditions". The

historical marker at this memorial site explains "Expeditions" and cites the service of the USS Parche (SSN 683) as an example. The ribbon cutting for the memorial was moved due to the recent winter weather, and will now occur on 18 May, 2024 at 1300.
