

U.S. Submarine Veterans, Inc. Albany-Saratoga Base

Location: American Legion Henry Cornell Post 234 23 Pleasant Street, Ballston Spa, NY

Minutes from 03 Jul 2013 meeting

1900 hours: regular meeting called to order by CDR Irwin with 17 members present.

- Chief of the Boat Al Singleman led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.
- Ten-Hut! As of 03 July 2013, Albany-Saratoga Base now has 120 members!
- We have one new member! Welcome Aboard mate!
- Drew Millier of Ballston Spa qual boat: USS Olympia (SSN-717) qual year: 2002
- Base Chaplain Janet Irwin offered an opening prayer, gave the invocation and tolled the bell for **boats lost during the month of July**:
 - USS G 2 (SS-27) 30 Jul 1919 3 died. She had already been decommissioned and stricken from the Naval Register at the time of her sinking, but is included here because of the loss of life. During inspection by a six-man maintenance crew on 30 July, the boat suddenly flooded and sank at her moorings in Two Tree Channel near Niantic Bay. She went down in 81 ft (25 m), drowning three of the inspection crew.
 - **USS Grunion (SS-216)** 31 Jul 1942 70 killed. In 2007, video recordings were taken of the imploded remains of a submarine which had markings in English, and propeller guards and limber holes identical to those on the *Grunion*. In 2008, the U.S. Navy acknowledged that the find was the *Grunion*. The evidence strongly suggests that *Grunion* was sunk as a result of several torpedo failures.
 - **USS Robalo (SS-273)** 26 Jul 1944 74 killed, 4 POW's later died. Sunk from an explosion in the vicinity of her after battery, probably by a mine off western Palawan Island, Philippines.

Base and associate members each stood, introduced themselves and stated the name of his qual boat and any other boats served on. Base Secretary Fritz Feldhaus verified a quorum was present.

Minutes from the June meeting have been previously distributed to members. Base member Bill Preece motioned to accept the minutes; base member Steve Cipperly seconded; motion carried.

Treasurer's Report - Base Treasurer Randy Stein presented his report. Motion to accept: Base member Tom Glenn; second: base member Walt Forney; Motion carried.

 Cemetery in Schuylerville.
