

# U.S. Submarine Veterans, Inc. Albany-Saratoga Base

## Location: American Legion Henry Cornell Post 234 23 Pleasant Street, Ballston Spa, NY

Minutes from 07 May 2014 meeting

1905 hours: regular meeting called to order by CDR Irwin, 20 members present.

- Chief of the Boat led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance to the US Flag.
- Base Chaplain Janet Irwin offered an opening prayer, gave the invocation and tolled the bell for **boats lost during the month of May.**

USS Lagarto (SS-371) 03 May 1945 – 86 killed. Post-war examination of Japanese records revealed the most likely reason for *Lagarto*'s silence: on 3 May, Minelayer *Hatsutaka* made an attack on a submerged submarine in 30 fathoms of water in Gulf of Siam.

**USS Squalus (SS-192)** 23 May 1939 – 26 died. Foundered off Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

**USS Scorpion (SS-589)** 22 May 1968 – 99 died. The best available evidence indicates that Scorpion sank in the Atlantic Ocean on May 22, 1968. Several theories and explanations have been given as cause of the loss, but none are conclusive.

USS Barbel (SS-580) 01 May 1989 – 2 drowned. Heavy waves washed three sailors from the deck of the submarine while operating off Kyushu, Japan. One sailor rescued.

Minutes from the April 2014 meeting have been previously distributed to members. Motion to accept the minutes was deferred till the June meeting.

**Treasurer's Report** - Base Treasurer Randy Stein presented his report. Motion to accept the report: Base member Kurt von Maucher; seconded: Sr. Vice Commander Tom Glenn.

We have lost 7 members who for one reason or another have not rejoined the Base. Current membership total: 119.
