

USS Wahoo (SS 238) Lost 11 Oct 1943 79 lost Sunk in or near La Perouse Strait. USS Dorado (SS 248) Lost 12 Oct 1943 78 lost Sunk in the western Atlantic. USS Escolar (SS\_294) Lost 1 Oct 1944 82 lost Sunk east off 33deg N and 127deg E. USS Shark (SS 314) Lost 24 Oct 1944 90 lost Sunk midway between Hainan and Bashi Channel USS Seawolf (SS 197) Lost 3 Oct 1944 102 lost Sunk just north of Morotai USS O 5 (SS 66) Lost 18 Oct 1923 2 lost Sunk off Panama Canal. USS S 44 (SS 155) Lost 7 Oct 1943 56 lost Sunk one day out of Attu USS Tang (SS 306) Lost 25 Oct 1944 83 lost Sunk in north end of Formosa Strait. USS Darter (SS 227) Lost 24 Oct 1944 Crew rescued. Grounded on Bombay Shoal off Palawan.
